DESCRIPTION

The Comanche Nation Housing Authority provides housing assistance, homelessness prevention, affordable housing, homeownership opportunities, and home repair programs for eligible individuals and families. Programs have different income, residency, and tribal eligibility requirements.

The Tenant Based Assistance Program provides emergency housing assistance for individuals and families at risk of homelessness due to circumstances such as eviction, displacement from a natural disaster, a landlord selling the home, domestic violence or unsafe living situations, or staying in a shelter. Assistance may include a rental deposit, first month's rent, and utility connection costs. This program may serve members of any tribe as well as non-Native households, although the amount of assistance available may differ based on eligibility.

The Lease Purchase Program provides a pathway to homeownership for eligible Comanche Nation members. Approved applicants may have an eligible home purchased through the program and make affordable monthly payments toward eventual ownership. Income requirements, background checks, property requirements, and a waiting list apply.

The Low Rent Program provides affordable rental housing through properties owned by the Housing Authority. Comanche Nation members receive preference, but enrolled members of other tribes may also qualify. Eligibility is based on household income and other program requirements, and a waiting list may apply.

The Home Improvement Program helps eligible Comanche Nation homeowners address needed or emergency home repairs, which may include plumbing, electrical systems, heating and air conditioning (HVAC), roofing, fencing, and other qualifying repairs. Applicants must own the home and provide required documentation of homeownership and tribal eligibility.

The Elder Program assists eligible Comanche Nation elders age 62 and older with qualifying home repairs, improvements, or needed household appliances. A waiting list and additional program requirements may apply.

Contact the Comanche Nation Housing Authority to confirm current eligibility requirements, income limits, available funding, required documentation, and waiting list status before applying.

DESCRIPTION

Comanche Residential Youth Shelter (CRYS) provides emergency and longer-term residential shelter, care, and supportive services for children and youth who need a safe and stable place to stay. Emergency shelter placement may be available on short notice, while residential placements can provide care for several months or longer depending on the youth's needs and circumstances.

CRYS provides meals and snacks, individual rooms, clothing, counseling, medical and dental care, recreational activities, outings, and opportunities to participate in cultural events. Youth ages 15 and older may also receive Independent Living Skills services to help prepare for life outside of shelter care by developing practical skills for independent adulthood.

The shelter also provides limited respite care for children in tribal custody who need temporary placement during a foster family emergency. CRYS staff provide supervision, support, and a nurturing residential environment focused on the safety, stability, and well-being of children and youth in their care.
