The program supports women and their families through a holistic approach to recovery that incorporates cultural and spiritual identity, physical and emotional wellness, education, parenting, and family healing.

Residential treatment includes substance use recovery services, relapse prevention, individual and group counseling, family support, parenting education, life skills development, health education, and culturally based activities. The program is designed to provide a supportive residential environment where women can address substance use while strengthening their overall well-being, family relationships, and recovery skills.

Applicants must have a CDIB and meet the program's substance use disorder and admission requirements. Choctaw Nation tribal members may apply regardless of where they live. Members of other federally recognized tribes may also qualify but must reside within the Choctaw Nation service area. A telephone screening and admissions application are required, and court-related cases or referrals are considered individually.

The program provides a supportive residential community that incorporates cultural connection and addresses spiritual, emotional, physical, and social wellness while helping participants work toward recovery from drug or alcohol addiction.

Each participant receives an assessment and individualized treatment plan. Services include individual, group, and family therapy; case management and navigation services; clinical and social withdrawal management; addiction education; relapse prevention; experiential therapy; nutrition and wellness education; tobacco cessation education; domestic violence prevention services; and educational support, including high school equivalency services upon request.

Good Road serves eligible First Americans age 18 and older who have a CDIB or citizenship in a federally recognized tribe and have a desire to become free from addiction. Medical or mental health assessments may be required as part of the admission process. The program serves eligible individuals within the Chickasaw Nation service area as well as Chickasaw citizens living outside the Chickasaw Nation’s boundaries.

Firststep, a program of OKC Metro Alliance, provides long-term residential substance use recovery services in Oklahoma City with no out-of-pocket program cost to residents. The program combines a structured recovery environment with employment, supportive services, recovery meetings, classes, and transportation.

Residents are employed through OKC Metro Alliance and work in community job placements for up to 40 hours per week. Income generated through these community partnerships helps support the residential program. Transportation is provided to and from work as well as qualifying appointments, services, and meetings. Residents also have access to recovery-focused classes and meetings offered on campus and online.

The residential program generally lasts from six months to two years and requires participants to be willing and medically able to work. Admission begins with a telephone screening. Applicants must have a state-issued ID and do not need health insurance to participate. Additional admission and medication requirements apply, so individuals should contact Firststep directly to confirm current eligibility and screening requirements.
